## The Song of the Lord

In every move of the Spirit it seems the Lord anoints the worship in a special way; putting His finger at times on a particular song or style. Almost like that music was ordained "for such a time as this." We know that the Lord is the same yesterday, today and forever but I say to you He is singing a new song. He is releasing a new sound. In **Isaiah 42:9-10** "*Behold, the former things are come to pass, and new things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them. Sing unto the Lord a new song, and his praise from the end of the earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof.*" And in **Isaiah 42:19** he talks about doing a new thing, a springing forth in a dry place, a refreshing a revival of the heart of worship and the heart of the worshipper.

When we are speaking here about the song of the Lord I am not necessarily referring to this new music being released. I am specifically speaking of the spontaneous, prophetic song that the Lord ordains in the heart of worship. You hear him talk about that occurring at Azuza Street, the Welsh

Revival, and other places where the Lord moved in power in the heart of the worshippers. But the place that I personally saw this gift in operation more than anywhere else was in the life and ministry of Ruth Heflin, Jane Lowder and so many others at Calvary Pentecostal Tabernacle (CPT) and Campground in Ashland, Virginia and at their Jerusalem Mount Zion Fellowship.

Their revelation of the Glory, their heart to worship, their prophetic mantle and their openness to hear the voice of the Lord has made CPT one of the real forefront ministries in ushering the new of the Glory and the Song of the Lord. My wife Mave has that very anointing. The way that the Spirit operates in and through Mave is very poetic as well as prophetic. I remember when I first met her in Canada in 2000. She would get these wonderful poems and songs that would be exactly the message the Lord laid on my heart to preach that night. She often told me that she had felt in some way divinely inspired but I told her that I believe it was deeper than that and that that was the administration and operation of her prophetic gift according to **1 Corinthians 12**. Same gift, same Lord, same Spirit, just a different and unique operation. I also told her that I felt it was one of the 12 biblical channels and realms of prophecy that I had seen in the Word of God. In **Colossians 3:16** Paul said, *“Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”* This should be the natural prophetic overflow of a heart filled with the love of God.

I believe that you will find the rest of her teaching here not only informative but also be open to the impartation because this isn't something that she just knows about, this is a gifting and an anointing that she walks in.

The Scriptures teach that the ministry of music is to be a two-way conversation between the Lord and His redeemed. We are to speak to ourselves, to one another, (in songs and hymns and spiritual songs), to Jesus and Jesus to us.

During our services, given the opportunity, the Lord Jesus Christ will speak to us through worship. When this occurs, the prophetic word or song will usually line up with the preaching of the Word, and confirm it. There is a deep flow of His anointing to break bondage and save souls in the spiritual ministry of worship. This type of flow will only come forth if we yield to His Spirit, and understand the truth of His Word concerning the spiritual songs of the Lord.

The song of the Lord is the ministry of the heart. It is a spiritual song, fresh, and new hot off the heavenly press. Not everyone likes this song. It can irritate the flesh of those who have no relationship or intimacy with the Lord, but it will bring those who do into a closer more cherished place with Him.

Man was born with a great musical instrument – His voice. We use our voice in words and song to

praise, worship, to express love or concern for others, to speak to the Lord, to exhort, encourage and edify the body.

Music is just another form of communication. God formed us with vocal chords, and a windpipe. The upper part of the windpipe contains the vocal cords. Do you know what goes through that pipe? The wind, the wind of the Holy Spirit and as that wind blows across the strings of our heart it causes it to sing the rhythms of eternity.

The Scriptures tell us much about this beautiful song of the Lord. Many times we are told throughout the Bible, that we will sing a new song. Many of the songs we sing are praises or adoration unto God and Jesus. There is a difference between singing and praising and the Song of the Lord.

When we are praising God we are worshipping Him. When we are singing the Song of the Lord we are revealing Jesus Christ. When we are living and walking and He is our all in all, we shall sing this new song. To sing a song we have to have words and a melody, but the new song comes straight from heaven above, and no man will be writing it, because the NEW SONG is divinely inspired.

As we sing and follow the flow of the Spirit it is much like a river winding and taking us to places that are new and exciting. The river never flows straight to its' destination, it takes many twists and turns on the journey. As we follow the river of God we will flow much like a river sensing His changing flow, and His refreshing. Sometimes calm, sometimes through a series of rapids and churned up waters. God is never predictable. When the song of the Lord of the prophetic word comes forth it will be His way, sometimes gentle and peaceful. Sometimes not!

**Exodus 15:2** *"The Lord is MY strength and SONG, and He is become my salvation: He is my God, and I will prepare Him a habitation, my Father is God, and I will exalt Him."*

**Psalms 188:14** *"The Lord is MY strength and SONG, and is become my salvation."*

**Isaiah 12:2** *"Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the Lord Jehovah is MY SONG."*

By doing God's will, by sharing what the Lord is showing us, and by simply manifesting Him in our lives, we are singing His song, we are walking in His word.

Remember the truth of the Word in our lives is the action it takes. Faith without works is dead and will never produce for the Kingdom of God. We can talk and we can sing but if we can't walk we're not doing a thing!

**Psalm 28:7** *“The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in Him, and I am helped; therefore my heart greatly rejoices; and with my song will I thank him.”*

The new song is the testimony of Jesus Christ, and it has the power and force to set creation free, and we are the singers. The song that we sing is a NEW SONG— The Word of God.

Here are some keys to hearing him:

**Key #1** – God’s voice in our heart sounds like a flow of spontaneous thoughts. Therefore, when I tune to God, I tune to spontaneity.

**Key #2** – Keep your thought life pure and away from vain imaginations. An unsanctified imagination brings perverted revelation.

**Key #3** – I must learn to still my own thoughts and emotions, so that I can sense God’s flow of thoughts and emotions within me.

Mave and I come together in agreement right now with you and we know that God confirms His word, we both believe strongly in the power of impartation and we are believing for you right now. Join your faith together with ours as we pray. Heavenly Father, we come to you in the Name of Jesus Christ, the Giver of the gifts and in power of the Holy Spirit. We know Lord that we can receive impartation and gifting by putting our faith together, by the laying on of hands, by prophetic declaration. And I thank you now that my brothers and sisters who are each month coming together and receiving the prophetic teaching are receiving right now an impartation of the gift of prophecy, the Song of the Lord, that the Spirit of the living God and the prophetic anointing would begin to well up within them. That they would receive dreams and visions, revelations from the heavenlies, that you would anoint their hearts, their voices with the sounds of Glory and the Song of the Lord. Let it begin to bubble up within them until it flows like a beautiful prophetic river in Jesus' glorious name. Amen.
